Special points of interest:

- Mulch under trees & shrubs to prevent frost heaving
- Rake leaves from lawn and landscape beds
- Cut back dead perennials & foliage
- Lower mowing height to 2.5" or lower. Be sure to add a fuel stabilizer to your mower after last mowing
- Fall clean-up's can be done at this time once the leaves have fallen
- This is also a good time to fertilize trees and shrubs
- A winter feeding fertilizer product should be applied to aid in root growth & thicken lawn. Also to promote faster green up in the Spring.

Winterization of Your Irrigation System



Winterization is one of the most important steps to maintaining your irrigation system. Climate plays a big part in the timing of when this should be done. In Iowa, with our colder winters, we recommend this being done in October / November or before the first hard frost. This is a critical service to have performed. If it is not done properly, your system can sustain damage during the winter months.

There are several different methods that service professionals use to get this done. The most common is the blow out method. This is done by blowing compressed air through the lines, making sure to get the water out so the pipes don't freeze up over the winter
